Thanks for your purchase of the Ghost Pro VR Tablet. Ghost Pro is advanced technology that allows you to see and analyze very transparent light patterns in greater detail. You will gain the ability to see ghosts and other hard to see paranormal activity in your environment while using Ghost Pro.

Ghost Pro Tablet Contents:

Each Ghost Pro is charged and tested before shipping to ensure that everything works out of the box when delivered. Please call 615-750-5972 if something arrives damaged.

1. To start. Press the power button on the tablet and swipe up on the lock screen to show the Ghost Pro VR icon.
2. Click on the Ghost Pro VR icon to start Ghost Pro.
3. Ghost Pro will start off using the front camera. Click on Choose Camera and select Camera 2 to get the back camera working.
4. Press the (Start) button to begin. Press the (LMT) button to amplify light. The amplified section is in the middle part of the incoming video. Words will appear at the top. Ghosts will use the available light in the middle of the screen to do this. Press (Live) to stop.

What's happening? - when amplifying, Ghost Pro is taking a snapshot from the incoming video every few seconds. (Speed Button). It then processes each pixel as a data value. It compares surrounding pixel values for changes in color. It then redraws the image highlighting the changes. The amount of highlight is controlled by the (Phase Button). Both motion and color change are detected with this technology. If you can not see much detail try pressing the (Phase) buttons to increase or decrease the highlight as needed.

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- Press the (Help) button to show camera options and bluetooth keyboard key assignments.
- Press this button  to hide and show the Settings control Panel.
- Ghost Pro can work with a bluetooth keyboard like the one shown to the right. A keyboard is useful for VR and remote operation.



Auto - Controls 30 or 15 image capture then Stops - Set to Auto to go without stopping.

Talk - (Talk 0) is off. (Talk 1) uses the light in the room to communicate via a 65k word list. (Talk V) works online and adds a voice to the words shown.

LMT ON - This turns Off and ON the amplification process. (Light & Motion Tracking)

Phase 8 - Controls how amplified you want the center portion of your image to look. This is very useful in determining if something paranormal is refracting the light. Pressing the middle button will set to zero.

Invert 0 - This filter is good to use if your image is too bright or just hard to make out. It has 20 different intensity settings that will help you bring more detail out of your images. Very useful for daytime images.

Hue 190 - The Hue filter gives the entire middle image a global color change that makes the image easier to see.

Ivy Off - This filter controls the Green, Red, or Blue values in the images to possible show light patterns that affect those colors. It will sometimes help things stand out better.

Speed med - Controls how fast you want the amplified images to follow each other. Medium seems to work the best.

Screen 1 - Screen 1 is normal tablet full-screen mode. Screen 2 is used for VR goggles if you have them.

Refresh - Press this button if the amplified output looks confusing. It will start fresh calculations.

Zoom - There are 4 levels of Zoom. Zoom in closer to get a better look at something. Some paranormal patterns are small. Studying and comparing one photo to the other is key to finding anomalies.

Rotate - Rotate middle image. Sometimes the paranormal evidence is upside down or sideways. Not sure why. Maybe Ghosts are affected by gravity in a different way than we are expecting.

Amp - Press this to turn OFF or ON the amplified image to see what the normal image looks like.

Analyze - Stops the recording and amplifying of each frame and plays the last 30 images in order. Back and Forward arrows let you look at each temporarily saved amplified image manually.

Pan Arrows - These arrows control the position of the middle amplified image.

5. While Ghost Pro is amplifying, press the UP or Down (Phase) buttons to get the best image quality. It will usually depend on available light. If things are too bright or too dark, try stepping closer to your subject or use a color filter. You can also try the (Invert) button. Invert is helpful in filtering out some light and might make things easier to see. The (Hue) button also helps with visibility.
6. If the amplified images are going too fast or too slow, try pressing the (Speed) button to get to a comfortable setting. The green number to the left of the Speed button shows the current image number. 30 images are recorded in RAM memory and are overwritten one by one each time a new image is amplified. Once you see something that looks interesting, press (Analyze) or the (Back or Next) button to review the image and look at it closer. In order to save the image to your tablet you must press and hold the (Volume Down) and (Power) button at the same time to perform a screen capture. This is the only way to save to the tablet. Once saved to your tablet you can share it using popular social apps.
7. Press the (Live) and then the (Start) button to start a new session. Once amplifying starts again, Ghost Pro will save over the older images in memory.
Ghost Pro needs a lot of RAM to run. If it crashes please restart App and try again.



Ghost Pro VR Instructions

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Helpful Tips:

- You can run other programs on your Tablet like Instagram and Twitter. Google Play
- Be sure to close all unnecessary running programs. This will speed up Ghost Pro VR
- If your Live video stalls or freezes you need to turn off any battery optimization. Turning it off or setting it to low will help speed up Ghost Pro VR.
- Press the (Rotate button) if you are reviewing an interesting image but can't make it out. Some of the Ghosts show at 90 degrees or upside down sometimes. Not sure why?
- Pressing the power button on the bluetooth controller will Reset Ghost Pro VR
- Swipe up on your tablet and Hold down on the [] Square to (**Screen Capture**) your image. Your captured images are in your ScreenShot folder. Click on Explorer under Apps. Then click on Internal Memory, Then Pictures, Then ScreenShot. The Gallery App works also.
- If you're getting solid white or black in your video image try using a little more or less light You can also step closer to your subject. This is due to camera compression.

Keep experimenting. Try using a passive IR filter during the day.
Try adding a USB full spectrum camera to capture more unseen light.
